## How many will you help save from sickness, pain and suffering?

Dear Friend,

Many of us love cats for their independent spirit. It's all too easy to forget they depend on our care and protection just as much as other companion animals do.

Sadly cats are often treated as 'disposable'. I'm shocked by how often kittens are abandoned to a slow, painful death from starvation or exposure in a cardboard box or dumpster. Without loving guardians, cats suffer from disease, starvation and animal attacks. If they live long enough, they give birth to litters of kittens who often die of exposure themselves.

As a BC SPCA supporter, you deserve our deepest thanks for helping us rescue, care for and adopt out thousands of cats and kittens every year. That's why I know you'll be concerned to hear that with kitten season here, our shelters are bracing themselves for an onslaught of homeless cats that is about to reach crisis proportions. We're counting on your gift for \$40, \$50 or whatever you can afford to give today.

## In just one month, we will see a 225% increase in the number of kittens we shelter.

Just look at all the beautiful cats and kittens shown here and imagine 360 times that number. That will give you an idea of the sheer numbers of adoptable cats we'll have in our shelters next month. We urgently need your support to help us properly care for and shelter them.

Many of these cats arrive at our door sick, starving and injured. We need your help to cover the costs of food, medical care, vaccinations, ID and spaying and neutering – all vital to helping these cats get healthy and ready to go to new loving "forever homes" as soon as possible.

Cats are such beautiful animals that it's hard to believe how heartbreakingly difficult it can be to find homes for them. The average shelter stay is 59 days for a cat, compared to only 22 for a dog. The reason? Sheer numbers: every year, we care for 11,000 adult stray or feral cats and 6,000 kittens, roughly twice the number of dogs and puppies.

And those are the lucky ones who are rescued and brought to the BC SPCA. But most homeless cats face untimely ends full of pain and fear, often leaving behind scores of kittens who either starve to death themselves, or survive and give birth to more feral kittens.

Cats have their own math: 1+1=6, and that's an equation they repeat again and again. That is why we've designated 2012 our Year of the Cat to take on the root causes of the homeless cat crisis... overpopulation.

Look at the pictures of shelter cats in this letter... how can we turn a blind eye to the suffering of beautiful animals like these?

How can you help? Simply by sending your generous support to the BC SPCA today. On average, it costs about:

• \$40 for a health check when a cat arrives at one of our shelters;

\$110 to spay or neuter one cat prior to adoption to prevent support to pay the entire cost of one cat in our care, from rescue through to adoption.
